Since January 2020, Bodwell has put into place preventative steps to reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19 on campus.

#### PERSONAL HYGIENE

- 1. Use of ongoing hygiene precautions & reminders. 2. All students having supply of non-medical masks; used when distancing cannot be ensured.
  - SAFE SOCIAL INTERACTIONS
- 1. Ongoing education of students on safety measures. 2. Ongoing physical distancing on-campus; no large gatherings; use of outside spaces.
- 3. Use of online tools, blended learning and creative
- scheduling to avoid crowding of spaces. 4. Limits on boarding student off-campus privileges;
- limited campus access for non-boarders. 5. No Away-With-Permission outside of family

members; overseas visitors need isolation.

safety level.

- 1. Special arrival procedures. 2. Enhanced health checks; students with mild cold
- symptoms to isolate in room.

7. Visitor restrictions, including student contact.

- 3. On-campus quarantine & room isolation procedures and drills.
- 4. Overseas travel during the school year is discouraged; may require 2 week quarantine.
- 5. Information collected on any students at greater risk
- due to pre-existing medical conditions.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL HYGIENE**

- 1. Focus on touch-less or low-touch operations, procedures, operations.
- 2. Ongoing food delivery precautions to minimize com-
- munity person-to-person contact.
- 3. Kitchen meal service to follow BC recommendations takeaway meals.

#### PHYSICAL MODIFICATIONS

- 1. Reduced capacity of school spaces (e.g. boarding rooms, classrooms, etc.).
- 2. Use of barriers between staff and students whenever possible. Special meal schedule to reduce crowding.

#### PERSONAL HYGIENE

1. Ongoing hygiene precautions & reminders.

#### SAFE SOCIAL INTERACTIONS

- 1. Ongoing education of staff on safety measures.
- 2. Ongoing physical distancing measures for staff. 3. Use of online tools when possible for meetings to reduce need to gather.

#### **CONSIDERATION OF OTHERS**

- 1. Daily staff symptom checks.
- 2. Staff generally wearing masks/shields at work when physical distancing is not possible.
- 3. Restrictions on any staff with any cold/flu symptoms coming to work, likewise with any staff with contact with someone infected with COVID-19.
- 4. Restrictions on staff working in multiple facilities.
- 5. Staff advised to exercise caution in activities outside of work and to follow public health recommendations. 6. Staff overseas travel and contact with overseas visitors during the school year discouraged.

#### PHYSICAL MODIFICATIONS

1. Following all additional WorkSafe BC preventative measures.
